Unfinished, unpolished, unpleasing, but tough.

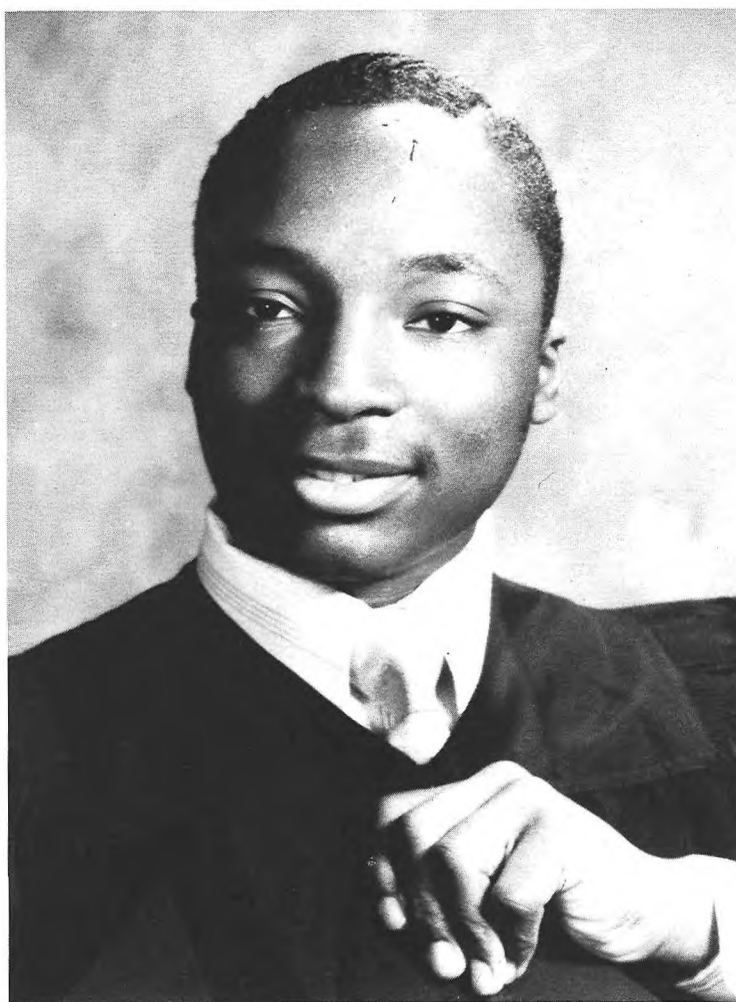
Returning as Sophomores, angles were developed, we were

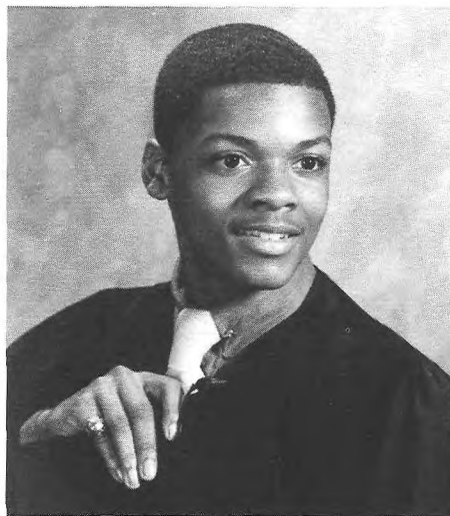
Class Officers
