THE BUILDING



The back area of Campus High leads to the gym and activity field. It also features rainbow colored glass windows and and a rear view of the tower reaching up to the azure sky.


The arched porticoes are a distinctive element of the architecture. They lend stature and grace to the elegance of the magnificent structure.


ACADEMICS

Technology class is not only a fascinating subject to these students, but it also prepares them for the business world.


In the Art Academy students are able to express their artistic talents, learn about famous artists and gain an appreciation for their works.









Hands-on experience makes learning more meaningful. These four students are engrossed in an experiment that will verify what they have learned.
