Clifford Scott pulled the major upset at the 18th annual NJSIAA indoor group track and championships yesterday at Princeton's Jadwin Gym, as it defeated Woodbury. 28-24, for the Group 1 title.

The other team championships in the two-session. five-division meet went pretty much as expected. Trenton ran away with Group 4, Asbury Park edged Overbrook in Group 3, Tenafly topped Hillside in Group 2 and St. Joseph of Metuchen won the Parochial crown.

Individual honors were shared by Renaldo Nehemiah of Scotch Plains, who matched a national hurdles record as he won the Group 4 event in 6.9. Kevin Byrne of Paramus Catholic, who took the Parochial mile in a record 4:14.0, Barry Anderson of Rancocas Valley, who set a Group 3 mark in the high jump at $6-8$, and Mike McCoy of Bayonne and Bob Jones. who both hit that mark in finishing 1-2 in Group 4.

Scott came from behind in the final event to win its first indoor state title as Blake Russell won the 440-yard run in 53.1 with teammates Steve Brooks and Vaughn Reid third and fifth. Russell had earlier taken the 60 in 6.6.

It was a similar double win by Tim White that led Asbury Park to the close Group 3 win, $23-22$, over Overbrook. White first tied the group record in the 60 at 6.3 , then ran away from Al Grant of Overbrook in the decisive 440 in 51.4

Vince Reilly led St. Joseph to the Parochial crown as he won the 60 -yard high hurdles in 7.7 and finished second to Tim Carr as the latter set a high jump record of $6-61 / 2$.
