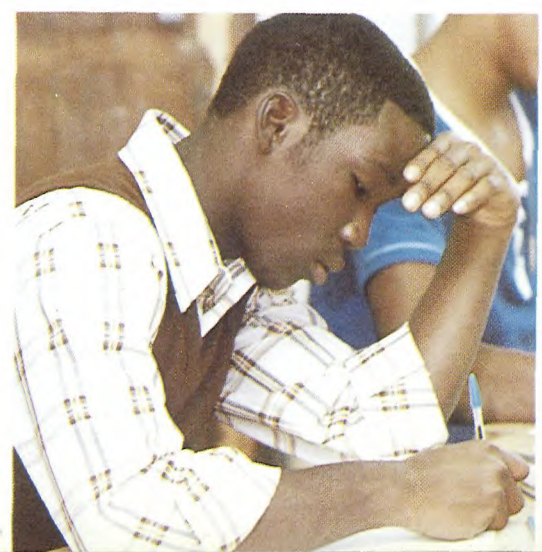
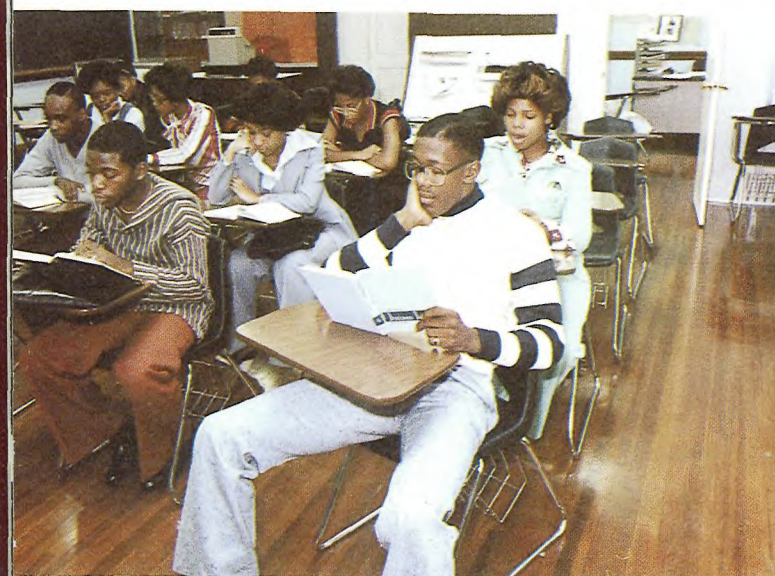
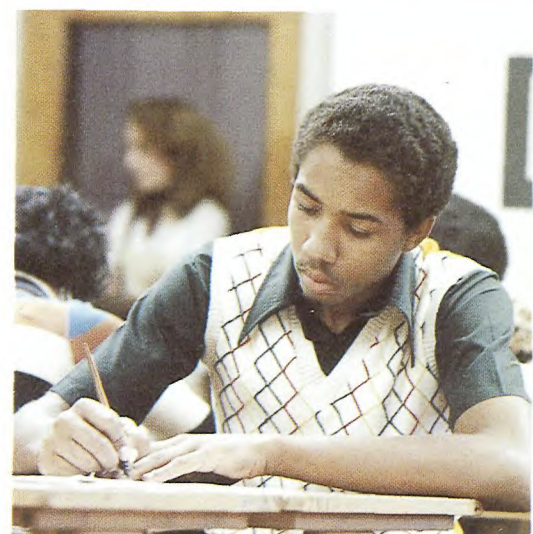


TOGETHERNESS

we'll always be on the move.





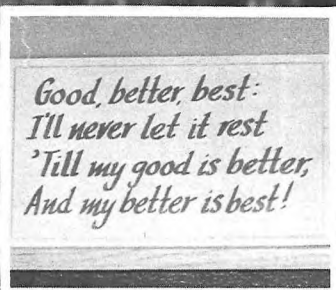
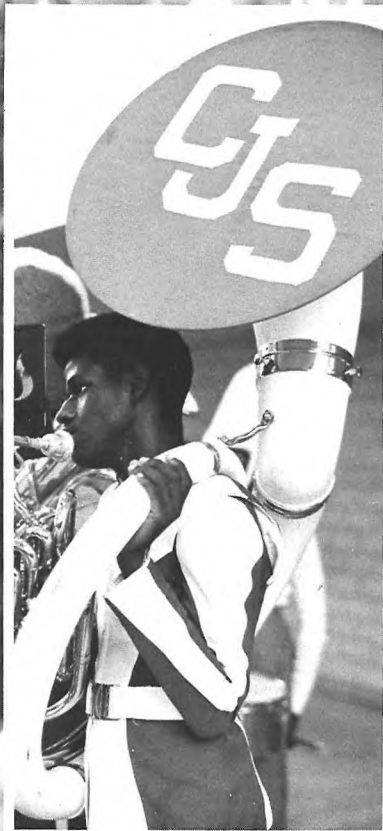
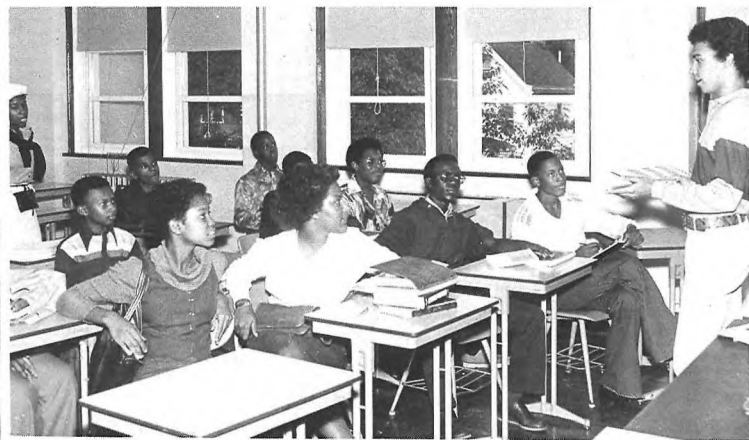




ENLIGHTENMENT

Reverend Jesse L. Jackson Visits Scott

On October 27, 1977, Reverend Jackson challenged Scott's students to drive toward excellence in education.

Reverend Jackson, president of Operation PUSH (People United to Save Humanity), told the Scotties to make no excuses for putting forth less than their best effort in school. "Don't allow your environment to be an excuse," he said. "Just because I'm in the slum doesn't mean the slum has to be in me."

The Reverend's speech was part of a national campaign to foster positive attitudes among students and it marked a new departure in the civil rights movement.

"For most of my life our people have fought to open the doors of opportunity," he said. "Now that some are opened, we have to fight to move up, and our attitude is paramount."

West Orange took the lead at 59-56 with 1:56 remaining for the first time since early in the opening period on a three-point play by guard John Skillman. But determined Scott came right back.

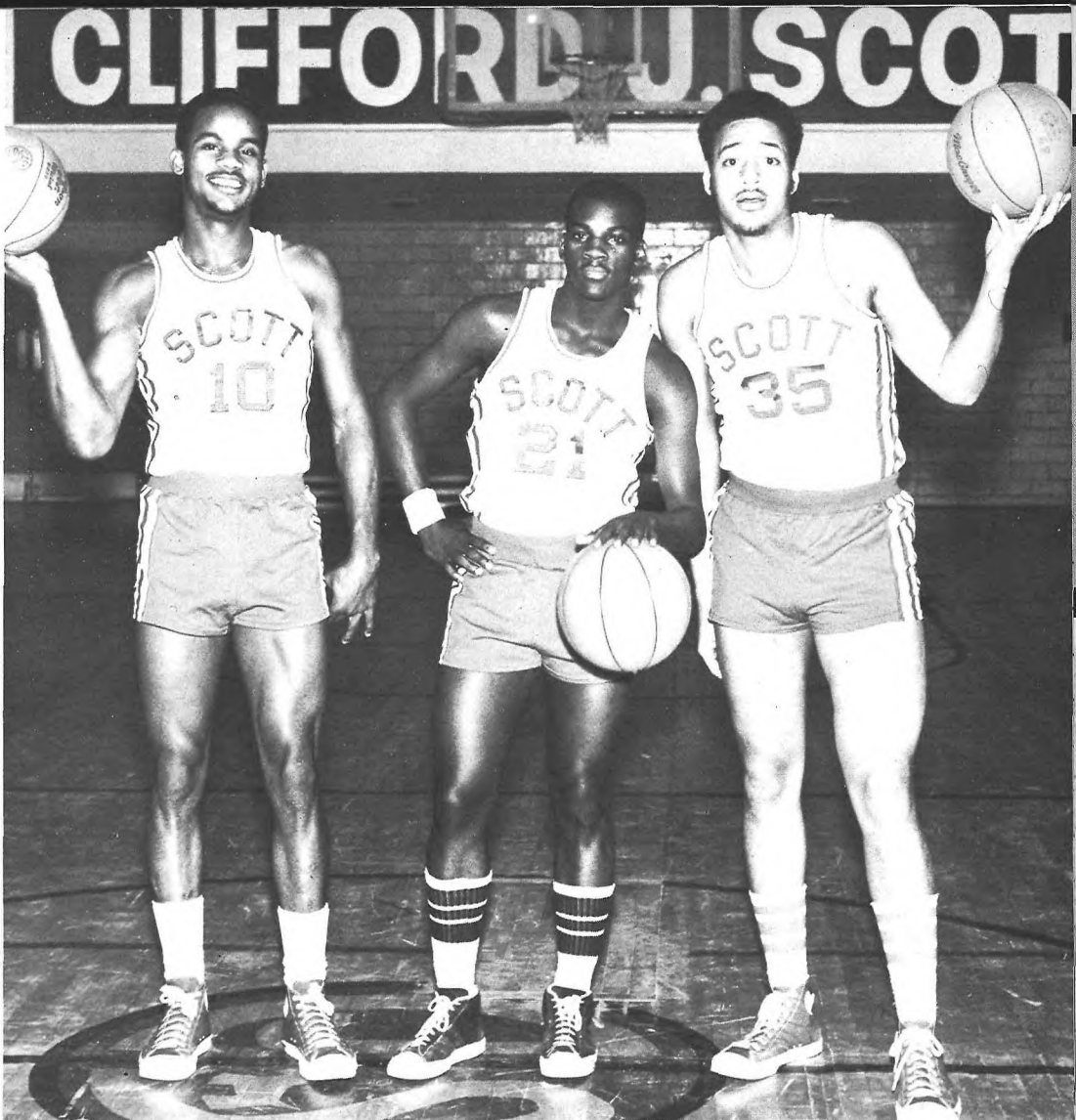
Junior guard Anthony Jordan tied it at 59-all on a three-point play for Scott
