From which our knowledge grew.

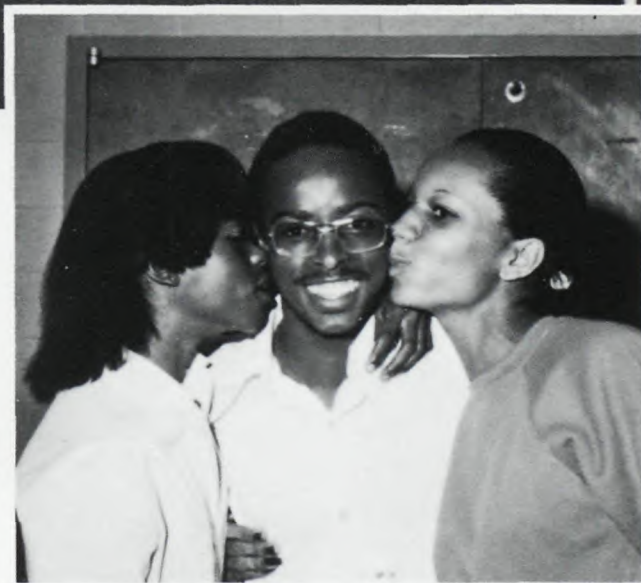
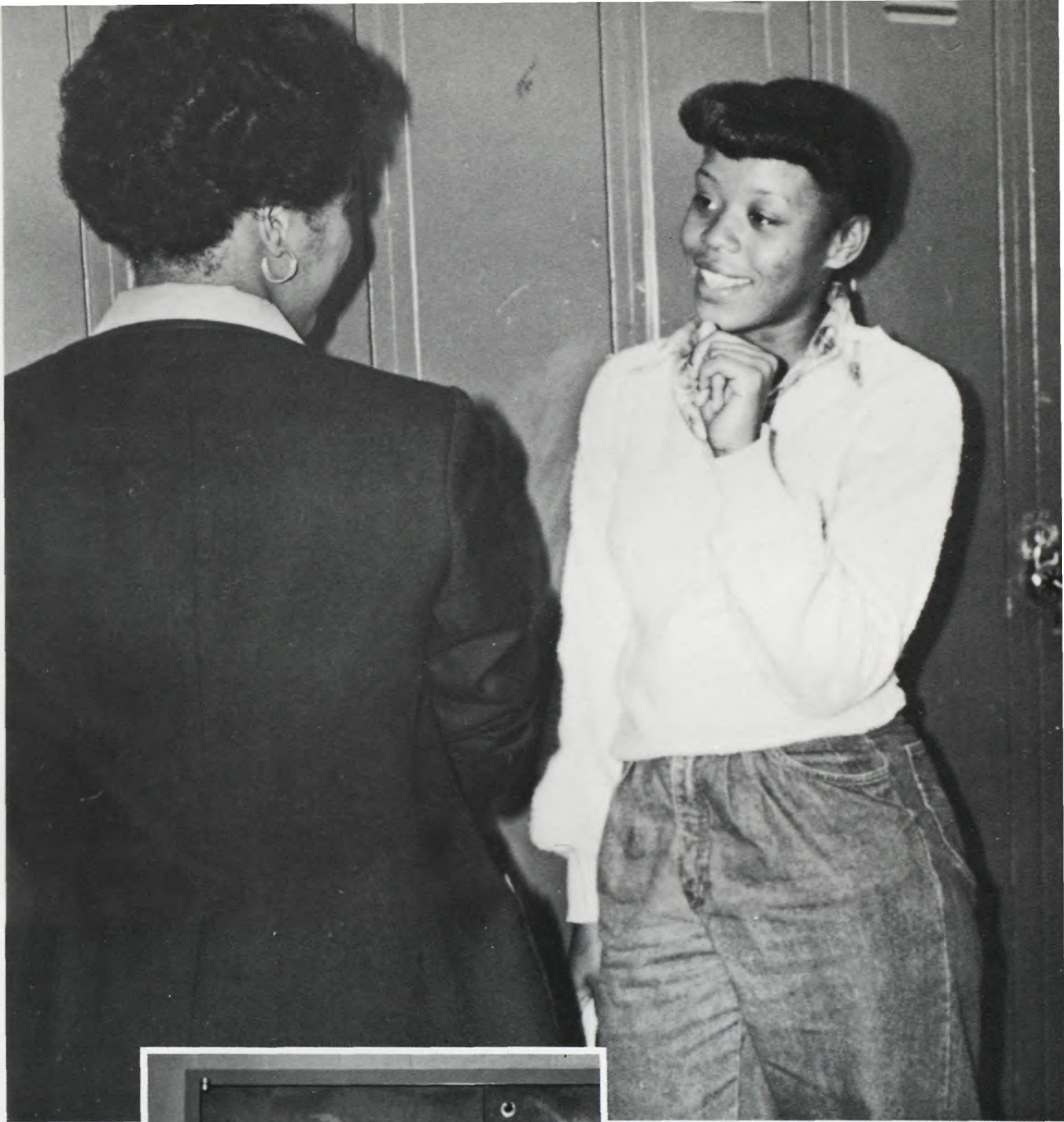

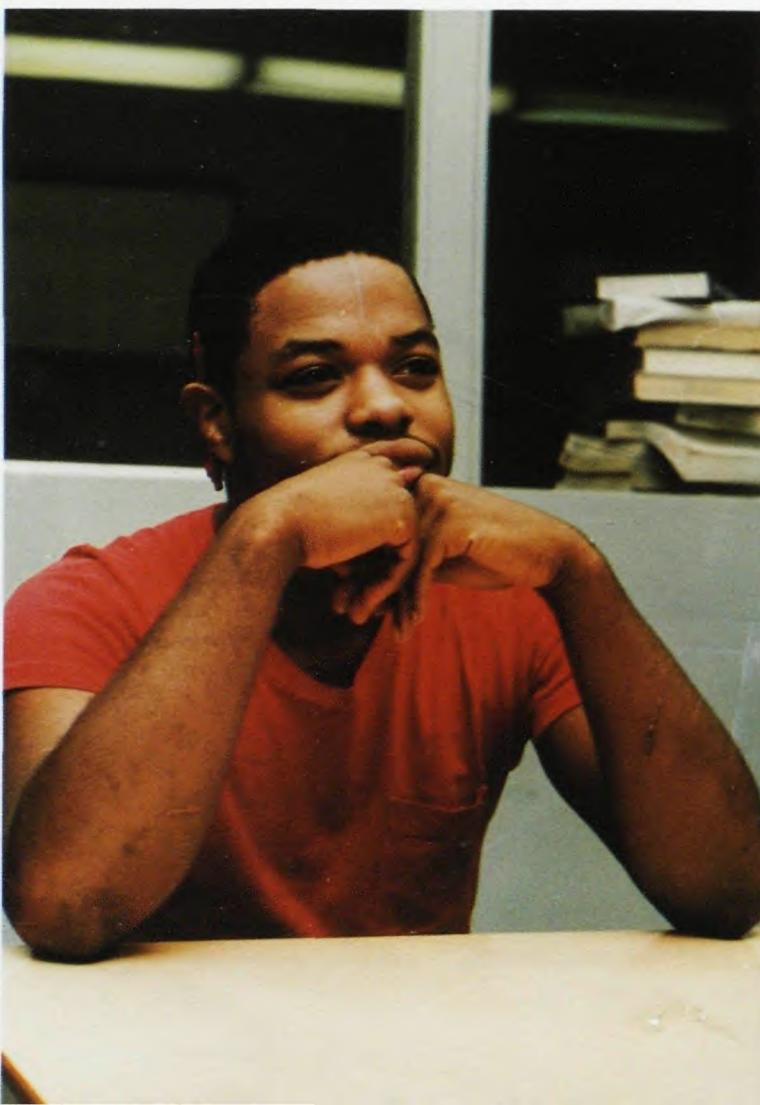

take only what is thine."





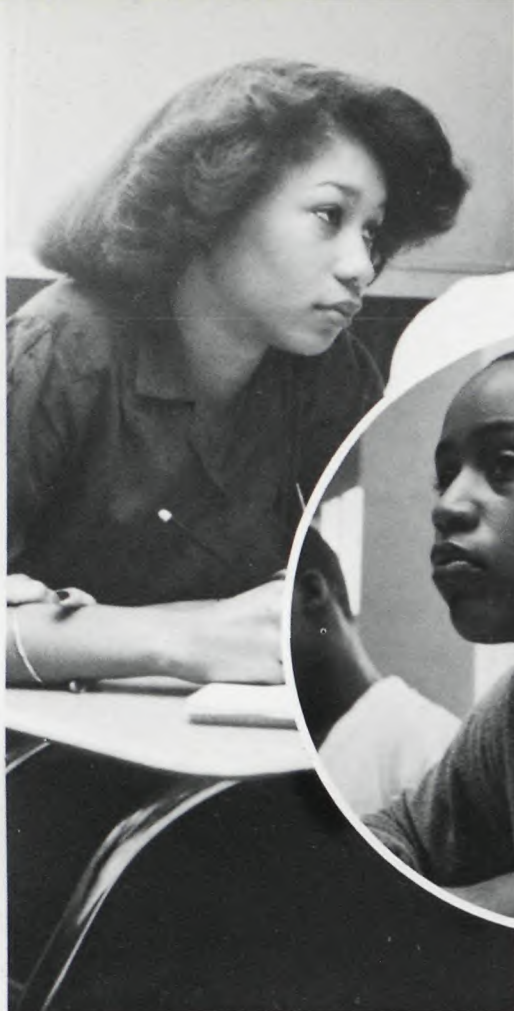

BOY ATHLETE OF THE WEEK

With game on the line, Webster's on the money

Troy Webster had been anticipating the showdown between his Clifford Scott basketball team and Hillside's since the summer.

Webster and teammate Mike Brown had joined Ed Manuel, Hillside's 6-8 junior center, to play together and take championship laurels last summer at the East Coast Basketball Camp.

"We talked about playing each other in the state tournament all week we were at camp," recalled Webster, averaging 22 points and eight rebounds this season.

Saturday, Clifford Scott and Hillside met for the North Jersey, Section 2, Group 2 title—and Scott came away with a 66-62 victory.

Webster, a 6-4 junior forward, scored 16 points in the final quarter—11 in the last 2:29—to erase the Union County power's five-point lead and earn for himself Star-Ledger Boy Athlete of the Week honors.

"I went over to Manuel's house last Sunday and he told me that they were going to beat us," noted Webster. "I just didn't say a word. I was waiting for the game."

Hillside had taken a 46-45 lead entering the final eight minutes of play. But, during a fourth-quarter time out, Greg Tynes, Scott's second-year coach, gave Webster the word.

"I just told him that it was money time," said Tynes. "He knows that when it's money time he has to take over. He's been in enough big games to know that he wants the ball at the end."

Webster's three-point play with 6:34 to play had given Clifford Scott (22-3) its first lead of the game at 49-48 but Hillside broke away minutes later with a six-point run for a 58-53 lead with 2:41 to play.

"I just kept telling my teammates to calm down and not to worry about it," said Webster, who hit for 21 of his 29 points in the second half. "When the coach says 'money time,' I just go for it all."

The next time down the court Webster took the ball on the left side and drove through the key to the basket. A deft head-fake later, Webster was vaulting over Manuel's outstretched arms to bank a shot home with 2:29 left. But, more importantly, the foul he drew on the soaring drive sent Manuel to the bench with his fifth personal.

"I knew he had four fouls and I was looking for him," said Webster, who has scored 1,143 points in his three-year career. "I love going to the basket."

J. J. Lewis interrupted Webster's tear with two free throws, putting Hillside ahead, 60-55, with 2:22 to go, before Webster got the ball again.

The personable junior drove to the basket again, this time getting fouled and hitting both free throws. Mike Brown followed with a jumper for Scott and Webster moved inside again for two points on a feed from Andre Adams for a 61-60 lead.

"I thanked Andre after the game for getting me the ball," said Webster. "They were double-teaming Mike Brown inside and Andre kept passing me the ball."

Seconds later, Seth Jones came up with a steal and passed to Webster, who weaved his way for still another basket that made it 63-60. A Hillside basket cut Scott's lead to 63-62 with 1:05 to go but Webster, who didn't leave the court for a second during the game, had one more burst left.

Webster went to the rim and was fouled as the ball dropped through for a 65-62 lead with 40 seconds left.

Webster then toed the free throw line and, fighting off screams by the Hillside faithful, cashed in on a three-point play to end the scoring.

"I could hear my father yelling to me loud and clear over the noise of the Hillside crowd," said Webster, who had hit nine of 16 free throws. "He was yelling 'front rim' and that's what I did. I just concentrated on the front rim."

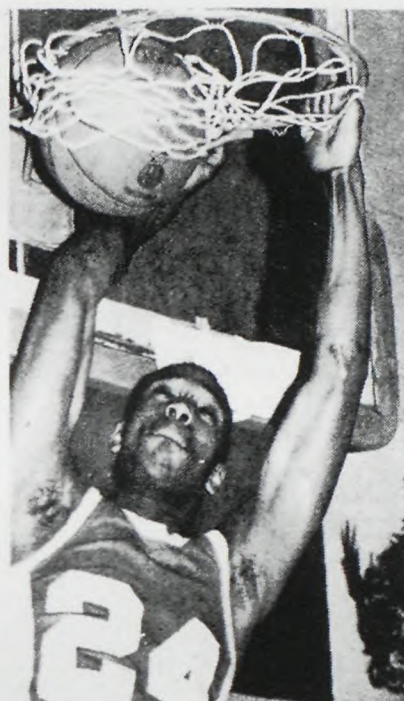

Webster's drives had given him a chance for a total of four three-point plays in the final quarter and he made two of them, including the last one that iced the game.

Webster, who plans to play guard in college and in high school next season, has been contacted by Villanova, Syracuse and Georgetown, among others.

But, long after he chooses his next place of learning and for some time after that, Webster will remember the game when he couldn't be stopped.

"It was the biggest thrill for me," he said.
