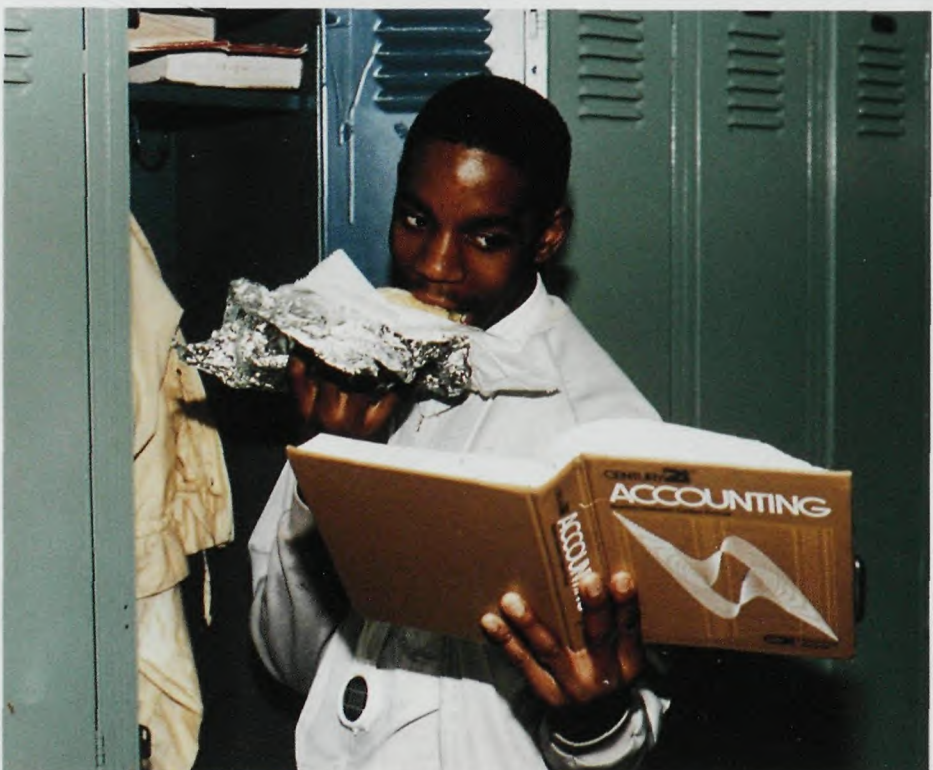
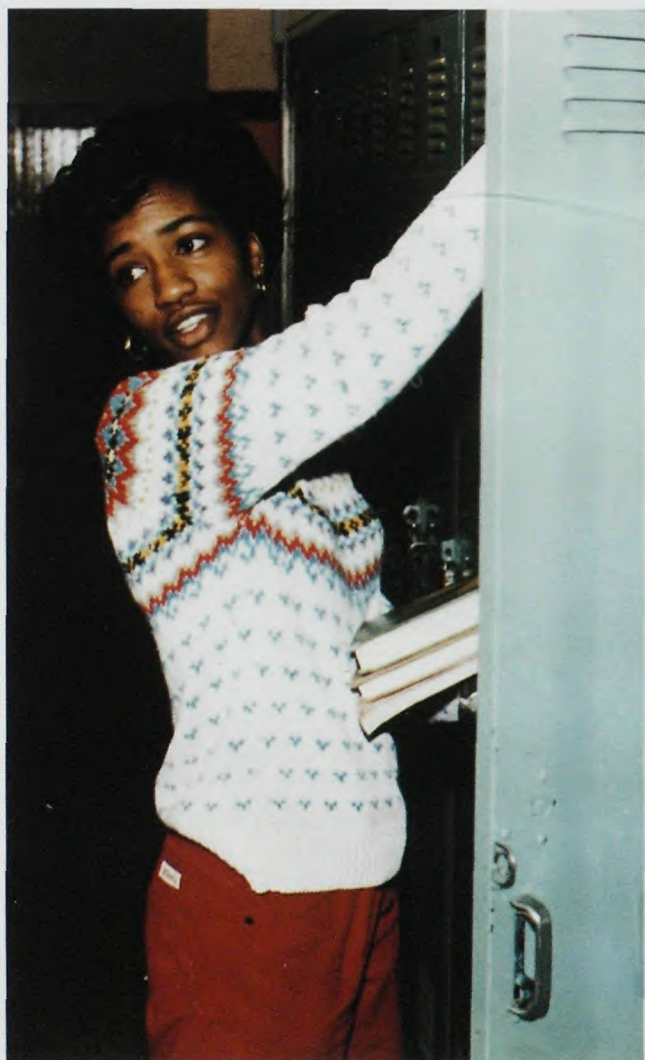


A PERSONAL TOUCH

MUSIC FILLS THE AIR

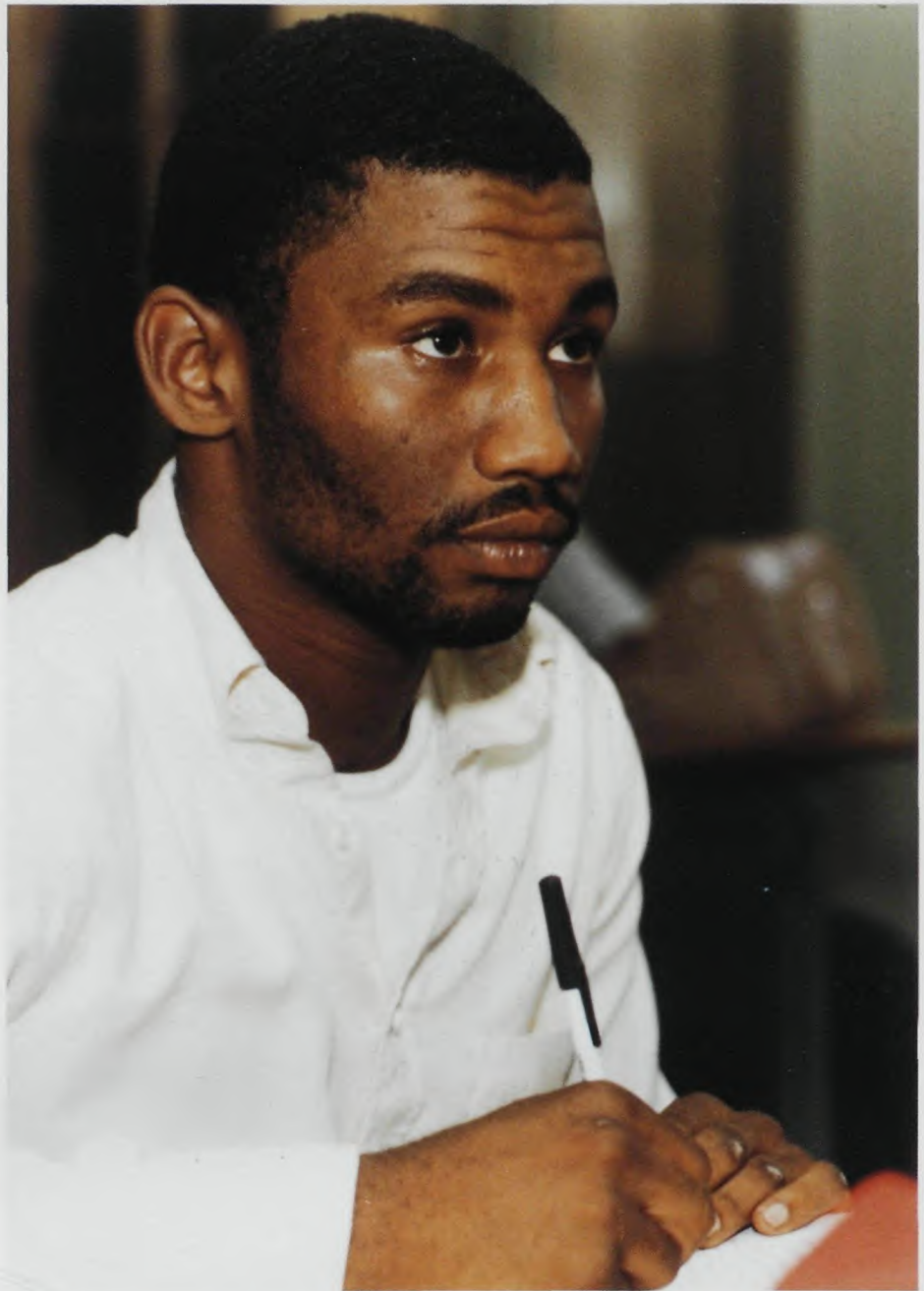

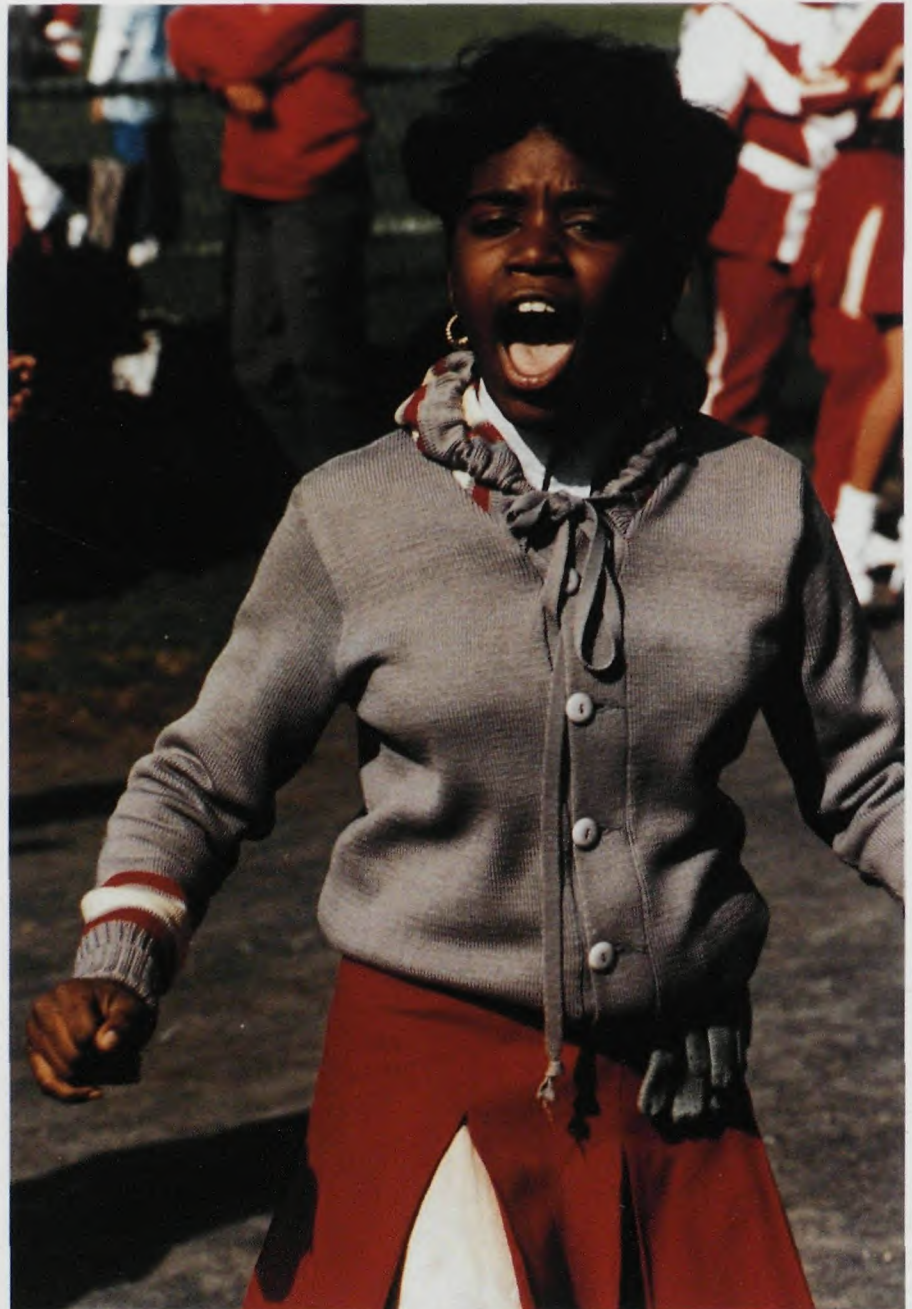




SCOTTIE SPIRIT

MISS CLIFFORD J. SCOTT PAGEANT

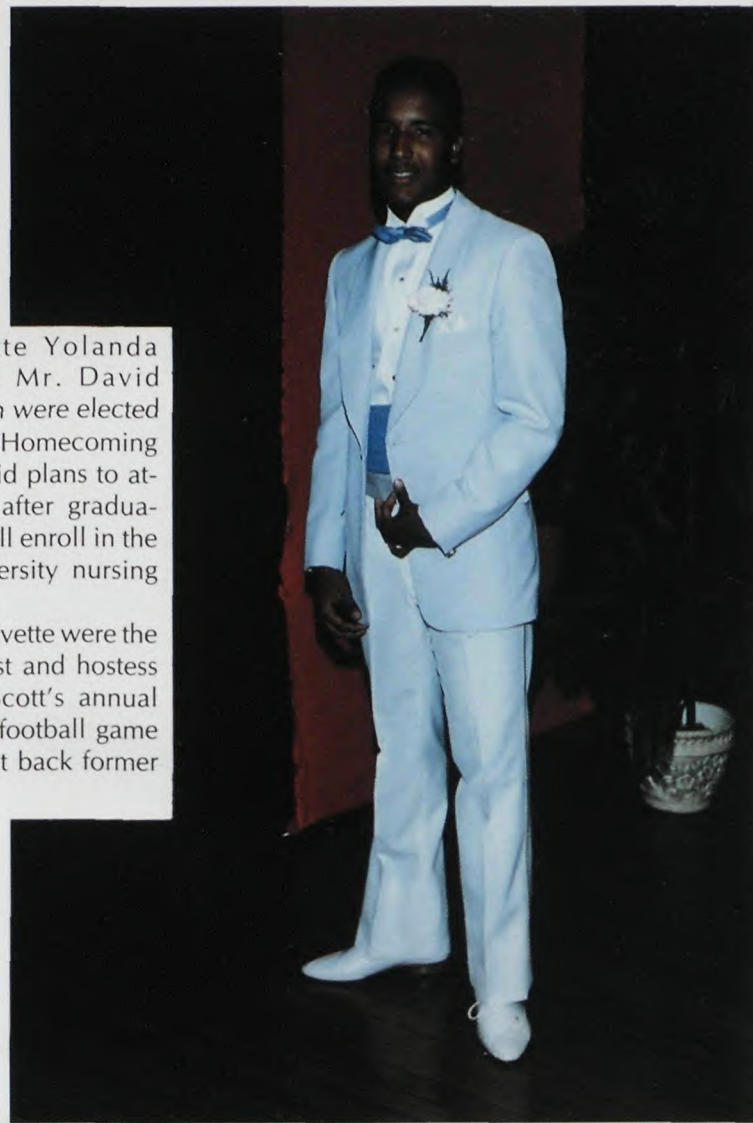

Clifford J. Scott High School's name belongs to a man well-remembered in East Orange, Dr. Clifford John Scott. Dr. Scott served as Superintendent of Schools from 1921 to his untimely death in 1936. He devoted his time primarily toward progressive improvements of the city's school system and the inauguration of a junior high school program. Dr. Scott proposed the plans for a new institution which would be located at the corners of Renshaw Avenue and North Clinton Street. This was the beginning of Clifford J. Scott High School. The cornerstone was laid in 1936.

C.J. Scott High School officially opened on September 13, 1937 with eight hundred and fifty students comprised of eighth graders, freshmen, sophomores, and juniors. On September 26, 1937, **The New York Times** published an article pertaining to the late superintendent and on October 15, the general public was invited to view the new building along with the unveiling of Dr. Scott's portrait which was painted by Edmund Nagrath, a New York artist. American flags saved to today were donated by patriotic and civic organizations.

The same 1937 photograph was unveiled and re-dedicated on April 4, 1987, the official C.J. Scott High School anniversary day.



DID YOU KNOW THAT?

The original school had twenty-five classrooms.

Soverel Field where sports were played by Scott students was Springdale.

Williams Smith organized the original junior varsity teams in football, baseball, and basketball; while Norman Whitten organized a "practice" track squad.

Football had an official schedule. Scotties played against East Orange, Orange,

Hackettstown, Newark Academy, Saint Benedicts, and Montclair Academy.

Male students were being drafted from Scott before they graduated for World War II.

Mr. Robert Johnston, 1987 retiree, was a student at C.J. Scott who was drafted before his official graduation from Scott.

Basketball Scotties only won four out of ten games in 1937.

Tennis was on the roster in 1937.

Scott High School has always been dedicated to positive reinforcement of the students who have walked its hallowed halls.

Dedicated faculty and staff have always been the "soul" of C.J.S.

The history and gymnasium areas were built in 1958.

The baseball field on the campus was named for Robert E. Miller.

The Media Center was originally in the guidance suite.

Mr. Powell met his wife at C.J. Scott High School.

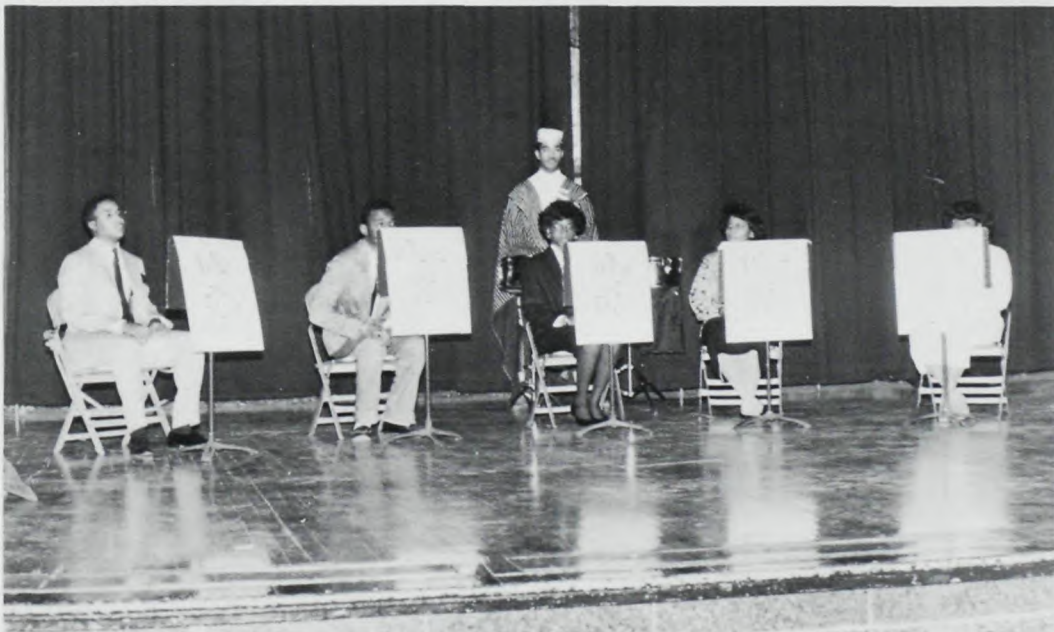
