# $\underset{\text { Cans } 29 \mathrm{FTs}}{\text { Scott }}$ to topple Shabazz

Clifford Scott didn't even wait for the opening jump to set the tone for yesterday's 72 -62 victory over defending champion Shabazz in the 43d Essex County Tournament boys' basketball final before 1,000 at Newark's Essex County College.

Derrick Bobbitt sank two free throws before the first seconds ticked

away after Shabazz was slapped with a technical for dunking during warmups. From that point, Scott, displaying From that point, Scott, displaying,
brains, speed and savvy, was confident, pestering and opportunistic. Shabazz never recovered.

Top-seeded Clifford Scott (24-2), ranked 12th in The Star-Ledger Top 20, converted 29 of 35 free throws, 83 percent, and watched 16 th-ranked and third-seeded Shabazz (18-4) hit just 52 percent, 11 of 21 , of its penalty attempts. Scott claimed its third ECT crown and second since 1984. Shabazz crown and second since 1981
had sought its seventh title.

Hassan Ellerbee, a 6-5 senior forward who was a model of consistency , netted 20 points and pulled down 10 rebounds for Scott, which got 20 points from senior guard Corey Brown, 11 from senior forward Bobbitt and eight points and 13 rebounds from $6-4$ senior center Raymond Goode, who teamed up with Ellerbee underneath to neuup with Ellerbee underneath to neu-
tralize Shabazz

Foster.

Foster, who had come in averaging 17 points, 17 rebounds and five blocked shots, was held to 11 points, 13 rebounds and no blocks against Scott's smaller front line that boxed out and hustled to limit its Newark opponent to few extra opportunities at the offensive end. Darrell Tutler, a 6-7 junior, came off the bench to score 20 points for Shabazz and teammate Malik Cox contributed 19 points and six assists.
"The key was giving them one shot," said Scottie coach Greg Tynes who won his second ECT crown and raised his career record to 205-45. "Ellerbee and Goode did an excellent job and so did the other guys. We did what we wanted to do. We started out in a zone, sneaked in the press to open it up and then slowed it down."

The effective Scott press again proved to be the crucial weapon.

Scott went to its full-court pressure after Ellerbee hit both ends of a one and one to tie the game at 12-12 with $1: 37$ left. Scott immediately came up with two steals that resulted in four straight points from Bobbitt on a layup and two foul shots to close the quarter with a $16-13$ edge.

Scott maintained pressure to open the second period and got two free throws from Bobbitt, who was six of six, and a followup from Ellerbee for a Six, and a followup from Ellerbee for a
$20-14$ lead with $6: 28$ remaining in the 20-14 lead with $6: 28$ remaining in the
half. Tynes then pulled out of the press half. Tynes then pulled out of the press
for good and called upon Ellerbee to take control. Ellerbee, who dropped in eight second-quarter points, scored six in an 11-4 spurt that put Scott ahead, 31-20, with $1: 17$ left to intermission.

Scott was in a bonus situation for the final $9: 37$ of the half and made eight of 11 in that stretch, while Shabazz was four of 10 .
"I was a concerned after Shabazz scored the last four points of the half (and closed to within 31-26)," said Tynes. "I thought we would have to get a few early ones in the third to reclaim the momentum."

That Scott did, getting a threepointer from Bobbitt and striking for the first seven points of the quarter for a $38-26$ lead. Shabazz never got closer than seven the rest of the way.
