Wilson dominates inside as Scott rolls

25 points,
17 rebounds
key victory

Clifford Scott kept calling Emerald Wilson's number and the 6-7 senior center kept answering yesterday to power the team from East Orange, No. 8 in The Star Ledger Boys' Basketball Top 20, past No. 10 Camden Wilson, 65-62, for the Group 3 state tournament championship before 2,000 at the Rutgers Athletic Center in Piscataway.

Wilson came up with 25 points and 17 rebounds, including 19 points and 16 rebounds in the first three quarters, to help Clifford Scott (23-2) to a 51-34 lead. Camden Wilson (25-5) made a

frenzied comeback attempt in the last period but was never able to pull any closer than the final margin. Eric Church nailed a three-point basket at the buzzer for Camden Wilson.

Clifford Scott, with poised senior point guard Keith Roberts calling the shots, dictated the methodical pace of the game and the Scotties' 3-2 zone defense frustrated the Wilson shooters who are accustomed to a faster tempo. Wilson entered the game with a 91-point scoring average.

"We'd been playing so well that, as a coach, I'm thinking we're going to have a letdown," said Camden Wilson coach William Smothers. "But I don't believe that was really the reason. Clifford Scott had a lot to do with the way we shot the ball."

Camden Wilson managed just 23 of 72 from the floor, including five of 25 three-pointers. Scott, which worked for short jumpers when not pounding it inside, sank 26 of 53 from the field for 49.1 percent.

"We played exactly the game we wanted to," said coach Greg Tynes, who guided the Scotties to back-to-back Group 2 titles in 1981 and 1982. "I didn't want to get into a man-to-man running game with them and we didn't. And we did a good job of breaking their press and attacking when we could."

The decision to attack or pull back was left in the capable hands of Roberts, who slowed the tempo to a crawl in the first quarter when Scott forged an 18-13 lead and then picked up the pace slightly in the following quarter when Scott used a 16-13 advantage for a 34-26 lead.

"That's Keith's choice and he made some good ones today," said Tynes, who got 15 points, four assists and five rebounds from Roberts.

More significant was Camden Wilson's inability to rack up its usual numbers against Scott's aggressive zone. With three men up high, the Scotties minimized Camden Wilson's open shots from the wing and, when the ball went inside, middle man Jermaine Mathis sagged into the paint to take on the center and help under the glass.

"We did not want them to get their shots from the wing. We wanted to let the point guard shoot from the middle and then get the rebounds so we could stop their second shots," said Tynes, whose team held senior guard Reggie Welch to 17 points, 13 below his average. Sidney Goodman scored 12 for Camden Wilson.

Scott's Wilson was aggressive but under control from the outset, sinking his team's first six points and eight during an opening 12-4 spurt. In the period, Wilson netted two followups, muscled against two defenders for another basket and was fed by Roberts on two more for 10 points.

"I just came ready to play. The whole team did," said Wilson. "They really weren't denying me the ball and the whole team reacted to that."

Camden Wilson was able to cut its deficit to 28-26 with 2:17 left in the half after Rohan Etoria's two straight baskets. But Roberts retaliated with a free throw and a 22-foot trey with seven seconds as Scott ran six points to open an eight-point lead.

Steve Rogers, who was held to nine points—he averages 22—opened the second half with a conventional three-point play that pulled Camden Wilson to within 34-29.

Scott completes 'double' with tough defense, 59-47

The Clifford Scott girl's basketball team, No. 14 in The Star-Ledger Top 20, used a suffocating 3-2 zone to gain a big first-half lead on the way to a 59-47 victory over 13th-ranked Egg Harbor in the Group 3 state tournament championship game, before 1,132 last night at Monmouth College in West Long Branch.

The Scott boy's team also won the Group 3 crown yesterday with a 67-60 victory over Camden Wilson at Rutgers. Clifford Scott had swept both Group 2 titles in 1982, the only school ever to win boys' and girls group titles in the same season twice. The Scottie girls won in Group 2 in 1982 and '83 and in Group 3 in 1984.

Union Catholic swept the Parochial A championships in 1987 and St. Anthony of Jersey City came up with boys' and girls titles in Parochial B in 1984.

Egg Harbor (29-1) had its best season ever. It was the school's third appearance in state tournament play. The last two adventures ended in first-

round losses.

Clifford Scott's defense keyed a 22-11 second quarter for a commanding 37-18 lead. The 3-2 zone held Egg Harbor to two-of-14 shooting in the second period.

"The zone is one of our favorites," said first-year Scottie coach Johnny Atkinson. "It was working extremely well so we stayed with it."

Scott (25-2), which led, 15-7, at the end of the first quarter, opened the second with an 11-4 splurge. Dana Wynne, a 6-1½ sophomore forward, had two layups and two free throws to key the spurt. Kim Curry, Scott's 5-11 junior forward, added two foul conversions in the spurt.

Curry, finishing with 22 points and seven rebounds, played all 32 minutes and was the game's MVP.

Egg Harbor, which starts five sophomores, opened the third quarter with nine consecutive points, the first four on free throws by Steph DeFeo.

Egg Harbor, which played man to man the entire game, used a swarming full court trap to key the run that narrowed the gap to 37-27.

But Scott regrouped and took a 49-29 lead with two minutes left in the third quarter.

But Egg Harbor rallied again with an 11-point run to cut the lead to 49-40 with seven minutes left. Egg Harbor's speedy guard, Shea Matlock, had eight of her 15 points in the burst. But Scott responded with a six-point run to take a 55-40 lead with 4:45 left. Wynne capped the burst with a followup basket.

"I really believed we had a shot but we weren't able to get over the hump," said Egg Harbor coach Sam Botta, completing his first season. "I

can't be more proud of my kids; they don't have any quit in them."

Atkinson explained Egg Harbor's comeback.

"All of a sudden we tried to dribble through the press instead of passing over it and that's when they made their run."

"Our girls were very nervous," added the Scott coach. "but they have the ability to put that aside and stay focused."
