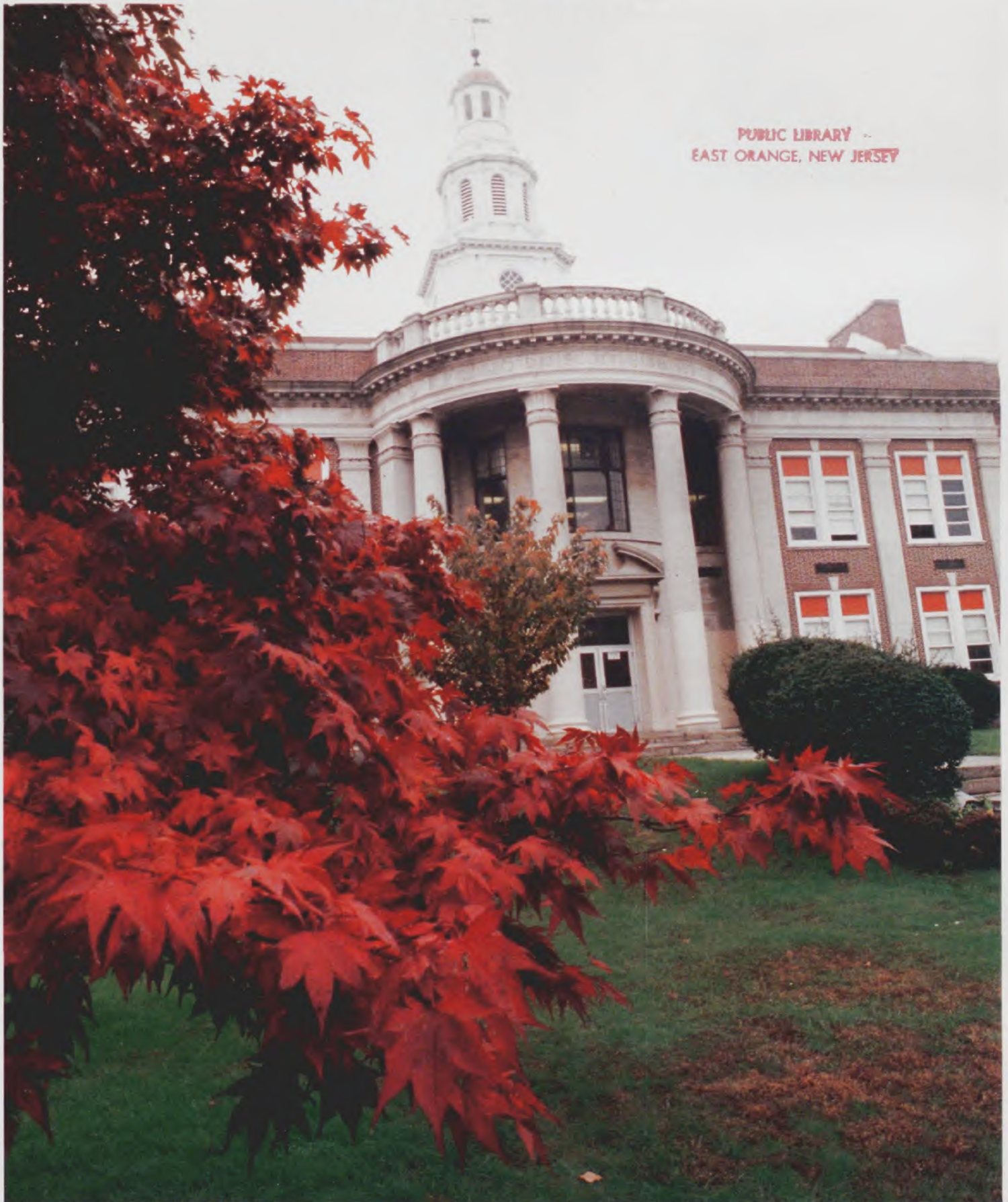

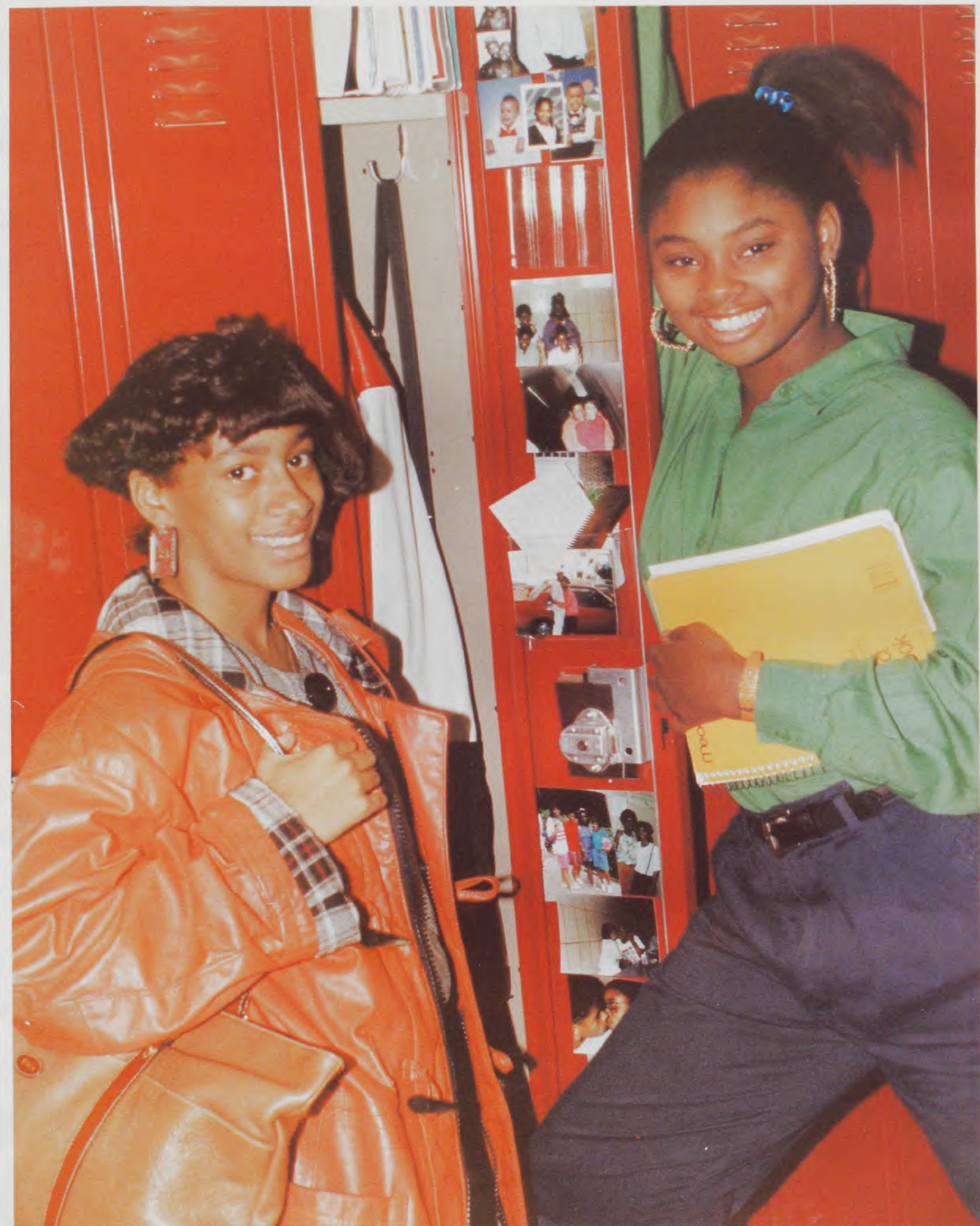
Beauty is the mirror of life.

who mirror what life is about.

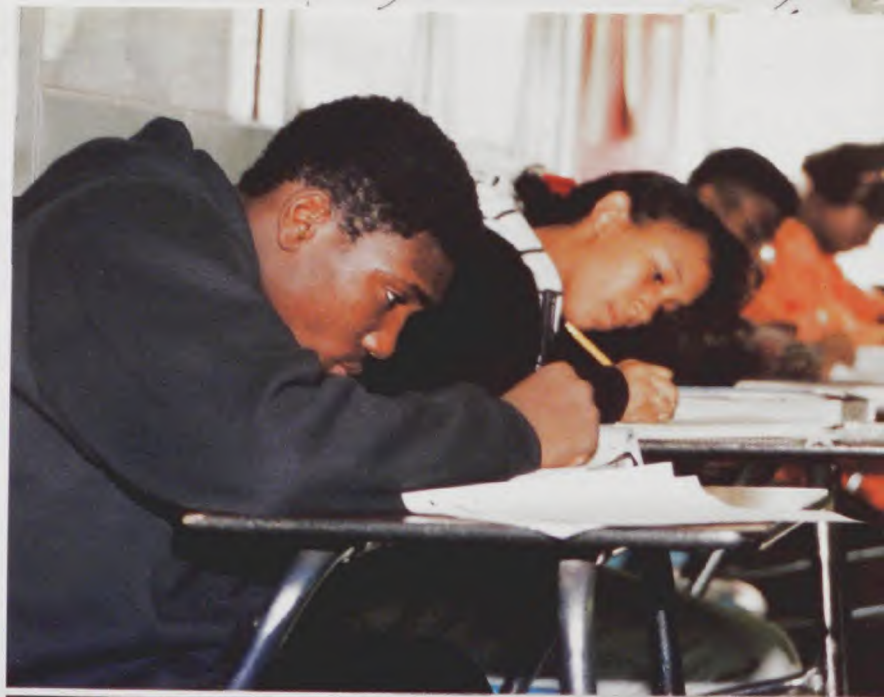


In my locker, I can go anywhere.

Until I come back, just think of little ole me. . .



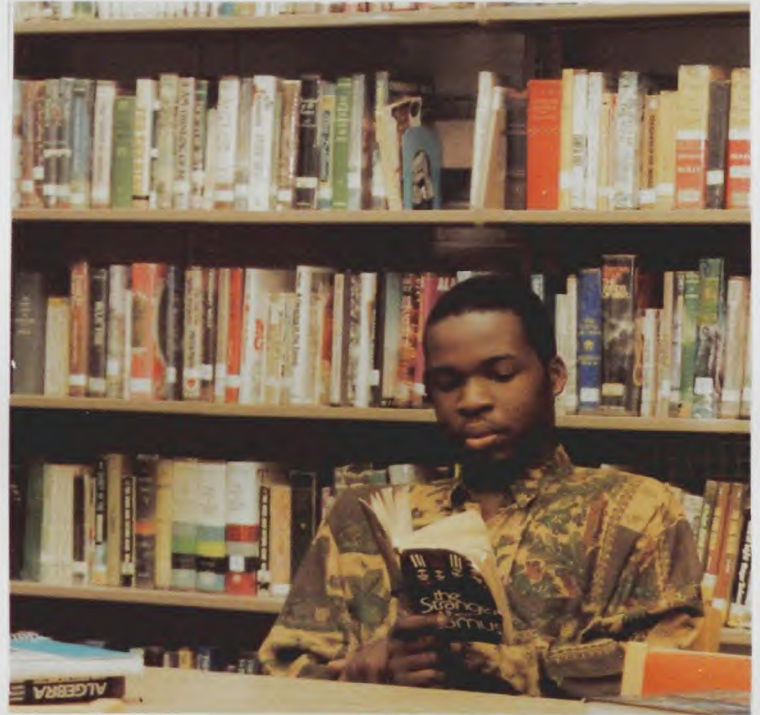

May you be **blessed** with a good life that includes helping your fellow man.

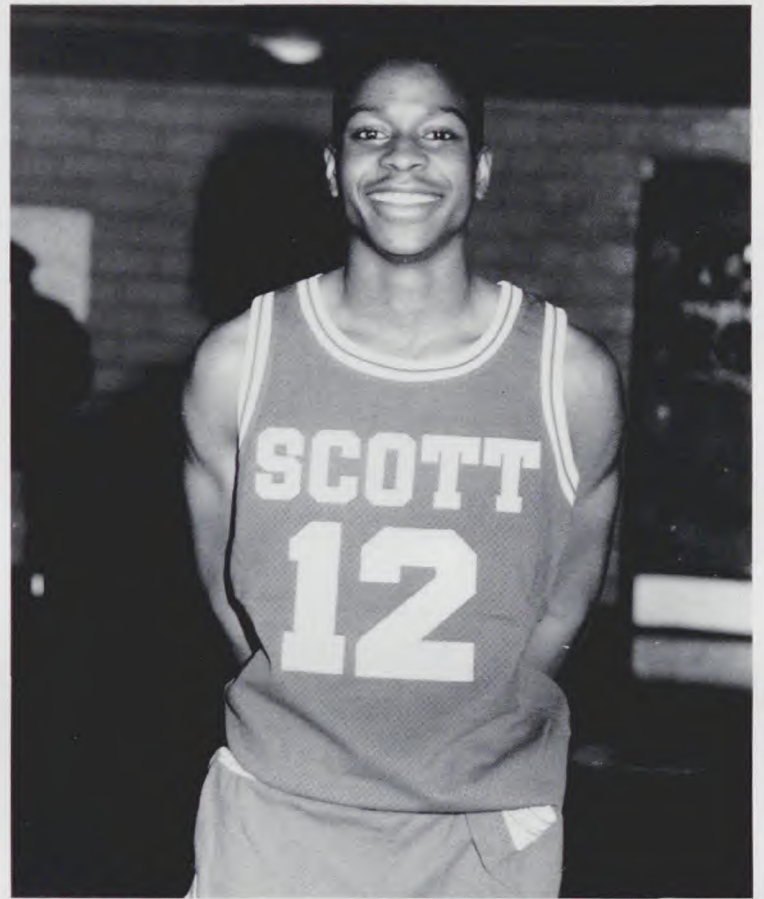

Scott beats West

Curry, Wynne, Turner lead way

Clifford Scott, No. 2 in The Star-Ledger Girls' Basketball Top 20, continued its mastery over West Side of Newark last night with a 55-36 victory for the Essex County Tournament championship in Bloomfield.

It was the seventh victory for Clifford Scott (23-3) over West Side (20-5) in the past two seasons. West Side has lost only three other games in that time.

Clifford Scott won its first county title since 1931. It fell to Shabazz, 52-51, in the final last winter before going on to win the Group 3 state championship.

Kim Curry, a 5-11 senior, paced Scott with 24 points on nine-of-12 shooting and grabbed 10 rebounds. Dana Wynne helped with 10 points and 13 rebounds and Marla Turner had 10 points.

Curry dropped in nine points in the third quarter when Clifford Scott used a 20-9 effort to take a 38-22 lead. To open the second half, Scottie coach Johnny Atkinson switched from a lady-to-lady defense to a number of zones.

"We tried to give them a number of different looks," said Atkinson, "and I think it disrupted them in the third quarter. We told our kids at halftime that we could not allow West Side to get the lead."

With a lead, West Side is dangerous because of its deliberate spread offense that can run minutes off the clock with each possession. The Newark school likes to put the ball in the hands of nifty junior point guard Sabrya Mitchell, who can drive the middle and find open teammates.

But Scottie sophomore Tracie Sims played Mitchell well, holding her to five points for the game.

"Sims is the only girl around who can play her," said Atkinson. "And she played her really tough tonight."

West Side, which got 16 points from forward Denise Anthony, opened with its slow-down game and trailed by only 8-4 at the end of one quarter.

"We just tried to be patient," said Atkinson. "In the first half, we were a little tight and we threw the ball away a few times. But we settled down and managed to get some balanced scoring."

Tracy Due answered with a three-point field goal for Randolph to cut the gap to 41-38 with 6:30 left.

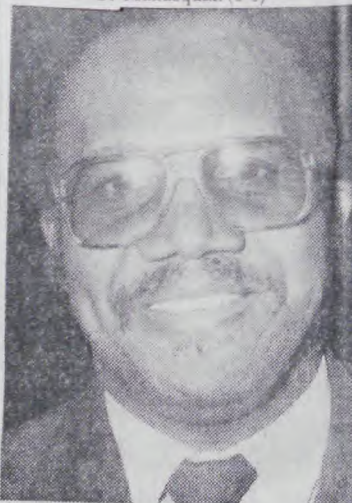

Two seasons ago, Dana Wynne helped the Montclair Immaculate girls basketball team to a 26-3 record and an Essex County Tournament championship. Despite the success, Wynne transferred to Clifford Scott last year.

"It was inconvenient and it was kind of expensive," said Wynne about attending Montclair Immaculate. "Scott is right around the corner, so I decided to come here."

Coach John Atkinson, who took over the Clifford Scott program last winter, couldn't have been any luckier. Wynne averaged 18 points while leading the Scotties to a 26-3 record and Group 3 state championship.

"She's a super kid," said Atkinson whose team opens this season as the No. 1 ranked squad in The Star-Ledger Girls' Basketball Top 20.

In Clifford Scott's first game of the season last Friday, Wynne scored 23 points and grabbed eight rebounds to lead her team to an 89-22 victory over Lincoln of Jersey City.

Also in the game, the 6-2 junior picked up her 1,001st career point on a layup with 5:01 left in the second quarter. Play was stopped as the Scottie players raced onto the floor to congratulate Wynne, who finished the game with 1,015.

She was presented with the ball, a bouquet of flowers and some balloons by her mother, Natalie, and coach Atkinson.

Acutely aware of Wynne's point total, the Scottie players on the bench agonized as she missed three straight shots from close range while at the 999 mark.

"That really upset me," she said quietly. "Not because of the 1,000 points, but that I kept missing. Any time I miss those easy, wide open nut-

backs, I get upset."

Wynne's strength has always been her inside play, but she is becoming more versatile player.

"She's been working on her jump shot," said Atkinson. "She can pop off and hit the occasional three-point shot for you, and she can pop to the foul line and hit the turnaround jump shot for you. When she does that, it opens up everything inside."

Singled out by a coach, Crawford Daniels, at the Orange Y, Wynne started playing ball when she was about 10 years old.

"He thought I should play because of my height," she said. "I started playing and I felt it was fun, so I continued."

Today, Wynne will be playing a long way from home. Clifford Scott opens in the Surf and Slam Classic at Mission Bay High in San Diego against Lakeside of Washington.

"It will be a good experience," she noted. "It should be a lot of fun for the team and myself to go that far away for a basketball tournament."

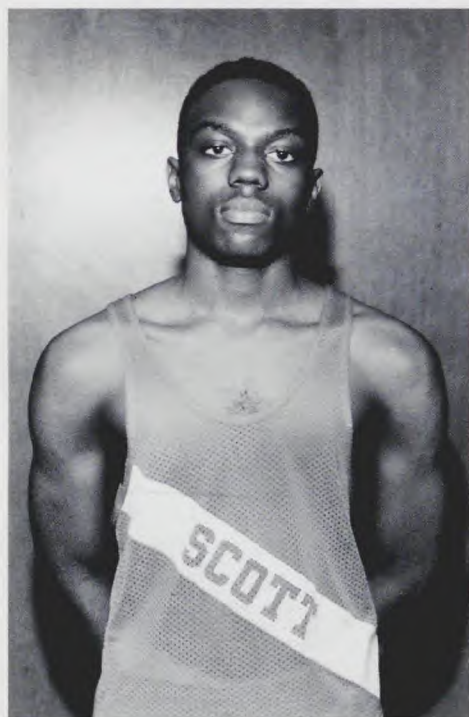

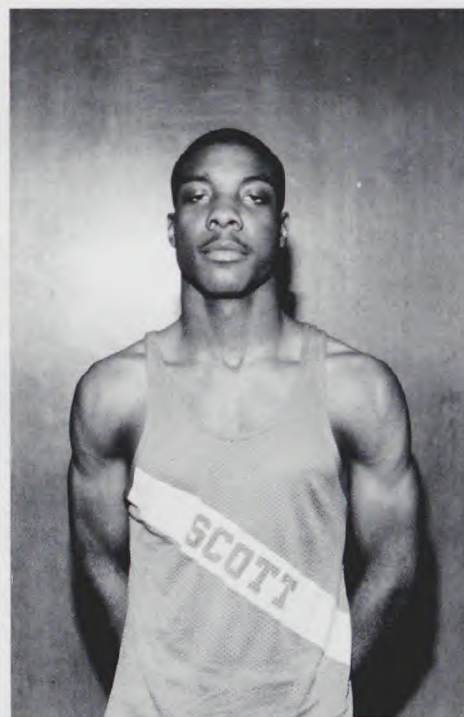
