6. Trustee Concerns/Comments

Hon. Jimmy Small asked if the Library is currently paying the PSE&G bill at the Franklin Branch. The Director indicated that City Hall has picked up that bill. The Library still pays for the Elmwood and Ampere Branches. Even though Ampere is closed, there is still a small bill.

7. Committee Reports

• Hon. Jimmy Small gave the Technology Report.

E-circulation continues to be high. Patrons checked out 637 e-books and audiobooks from eLibraryNJ and borrowed 503 items from Hoopla and Kanopy.

Over 900 patrons used the computers at the Library. In addition, many people enjoyed the free Wi-Fi and quiet study space at the Library.

The printing demand continues to be high. Patrons printed approximately 8,500 pages using the Library's SAM print system. Staff printed approximately 8,000 pages for patrons who sent jobs to print@eopl.org at

the Circulation Desk. Patrons printed approximately 750 pages using Wi-Fi printing service and most used electronic payment for their printing jobs.

The Windows 11 upgrade project went well. The Library ordered and received 23 computers and 6 monitors to replace public use PCs that are not eligible for Windows 11 upgrade. IT support staff resolved some issues with SAM software and Webroot antivirus software during the upgrade. The Library has completed the upgrade on most of the PCs in the Junior and Teen Center.

Verizon monthly telecommunication bill has been in compliance with the rate signed in the contract since February 2025. Ms. Tong reached out to Verizon to request a check for credit of overcharge and is waiting for a response.
