1. Sunshine Law

The Director has chosen Library Cross Roads consultants as the firm to assist with the Library's Strategic Plan.

6. Trustee Concerns/Comments

- **Hon. Jimmy Small**

Hon. Jimmy Small talked about Muslim Heritage Month. It is officially designated in January. It celebrates the rich cultural, historical, and social contributions of Muslims to the State and Nation. The Muslim League of Voters of New Jersey is hosting an event entitled “Our Muslim Heritage” on January 17 at the Library. Tonight, the Director presented a Muslim Heritage Month resolution. Motioned by Terry Corallo to approve the resolution as presented. Seconded by Hon. Mumtaz Bari-Brown. Approved by the Board.

7. Committee Reports

Hon. Jimmy Small gave the Technology Report.

The Library has successfully completed the Windows 11 upgrade project. All public use computers and most staff computers are now running on Windows 11 and receiving the latest security updates.

Ms. Tong worked with On-Tech e-rate consulting service on the e-rate funding application for FY 2026/2027. The Library will apply for telecommunication funding for Internet access and upgrading the Wi-Fi access points.

Circulation of digital materials continued to be high. Patrons checked out approximately 700 digital materials from eLibraryNJ and borrowed approximately 600 items from Hoopla and Kanopy.

Approximately 700 patrons used the computers at the Library. In addition, many enjoyed the free Wi-Fi and Quiet Study Rooms. The Library had 91 bookings for the Rooms.

The printing demand continued to be high. Staff printed approximately 4,400 pages for patrons at the Circulation Desk. Patrons printed approximately 8,600 pages using Wi-Fi printing service and the SAM print system.

IT support staff assisted AARP tax assistance staff with a test run of their technology equipment.

IT support staff assisted Trane staff with the network connection for the new chiller.

The Library renewed Webroot Antivirus cybersecurity software licenses.

8. Old Business

- **Legal Counsel & RFQ Update**

The Board of Trustees is soliciting statements of qualified and performance data from qualified Respondents for Library Board Attorney. All statements of Qualifications are due before 12:00 noon on Monday, January 12, 2026. Once received, the Board will review and make a decision.

- **2026 Budget Update**

The City Administration is floating another 15% cuts to departments this year. The Director is going to request a meeting with Council Finance Chair Leneus to explain how the Library has been operating on an austerity-level budget for many years due to prior cuts. This information is vital not only for budgeting, but also for the Library's strategic plan, which will begin this month.

- **East Orange Room Renaming**

In 1999, Carolyn Ryan Reed was appointed Library Director and won two New York Times awards for library innovation. She had such an impact on the Library and community. In memory of, the Board would like to rename the East Orange Room to Carolyn Ryan Reed East Orange Room. Tonight, there were talks on the dates of this dedication. It was suggested that perhaps during Women's History Month or National Library Week. There will be further discussions on the specifics.

Terry Corallo motioned to adjourn the meeting. Seconded by Hon. Mumtaz Bari-Brown. The public portion of the meeting adjourned at 7:40 p.m.
